A Standing Order is the best way to ensure that our Churches are supported and maintained. You set up the Standing Order and have complete control over it.

It is not a Direct Debit. You control it completely and are the only one who can start, stop or change it.



Electoral Roll Notes

1. The only churches at present in communion with the Church of England are other Anglican Churches and certain foreign Churches.
2. Membership of the Electoral Roll is also open to members in good standing of a Church not in communion with the Church of England which subscribes to the doctrine of the Holy Trinity where those members are also prepared to declare themselves to be members of the Church of England.
3. Every six years a new roll is prepared and those on the previous roll are informed so that they can re-apply. If you are not resident in the parish but were on the roll as an habitual worshipper and have been prevented by sickness or absence or other essential reason from worshipping for the past six months, you may write "would" before "have habitually attended" on the form and add "but was prevented from doing so because" and then state the reason.
4. If you have any problems over this form, please approach the clergy or lay people responsible for the parish, who will be pleased to help you.
5. In this form, "parish" means ecclesiastical parish.

Gift Aid Information

Gift Aid lets us claim back some of the tax you have already paid on the money you donate to us. It's a way for us to boost the value of your donation – at no extra cost to you.

If you're a UK taxpayer, all you need to do is complete the above section and return it to us with the Electoral Roll form. You must pay capital gains or income tax to the value of all the Gift Aid the charities you support may be claiming back in any tax year. Then we can claim the tax back on any personal donations you make.

This means that for every £10 you donate, we can claim an extra £2.50 from the government. That's what keeps our Churches going and hopefully growing.

If you're a higher rate taxpayer, you can also claim further relief on the remainder of the tax you've paid on the money you've donated to us.
